

Participant "Snapshot" - Refer to Pages 2-15 for ALL Detail

- i. If Participant is sick or displays symptoms of COVID-19, STAY HOME
- ii. Maximum sixty (60) World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Series field, IMCA Late Model field (Friday), and DIRTcar UMP Modified field (Saturday) by **preregistration ONLY**.
- iii. This event is NOT open to the public. You must pre-register to participate in this event. All pre-registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the registration limit has been met, we will no longer accept registrations. Registration will close at 8:00pm EST on Thursday, May 28. No registrations will be accepted at the gate.
- iv. ALL World of Outlaws and DIRTcar UMP Modified drivers MUST be current DIRTcar Members by May 28, 2020 *(Thursday)* at 8:00pm EST.
- v. Participants must wear a cloth face cover at ALL times. (*Face cover will be provided as needed to all Participants*)
- vi. Driver's and teams can stay overnight in their race haulers; however, all will still have to participate in the COVID-19 screening on Saturday.
- vii. Participants will not be allowed to enter the Facility before 3pm on Friday and Noon on Saturday and ALL six (6) TEAM MEMBERS (*Driver & Team*) MUST arrive together with their confirmation e-mail. Participants in personal vehicles can ONLY park in the designated participant parking zone (see facility map). A minimum of one (1) space (6-feet) between each vehicle must be left open. Once you enter the Facility you cannot leave and re-enter.
- viii. Upon arrival to the Facility you should be prepared for a COVID-19 Screening up to and including a Temperature Test and completion of a health questionnaire.
- ix. ALL Attendees **MUST follow CDC Guidelines** throughout the entire event from entry onto the facility until exit. See below for ALL Guidelines up to and including Social-Distancing *(6' separation)* and continued Personal Hygiene.
- x. Participants will be escorted to the Pits and should leave fifteen-feet (15') in between ALL Race Haulers. Haulers carrying two Race Cars must leave 15' separation between the cars once off-loaded.
- xi. No more than six (6) Crew Members *(including driver)* can work on a car at one-time in their designated pit area.
- xii. All Attendees MUST stay in their own Pit Area at ALL times unless racing and are expected to practice Social-Distancing in the Pit Grandstand and/or in your respective Infield Work Area.
- xiii. World of Outlaws, DIRTcar and IMCA Official(s) will execute Pill Draw and transponder distribution upon arrival and as part of the registration process. Social distancing will be maintained during this process as much as possible.

- xiv. Drivers MUST maintain Social-Distancing during the Draw process.
- xv. Work area will be outside turn three. Only (1) crew member per car on track will be allowed into the infield area for the feature event.
- xvi. The Pit Area food & beverage concession trailer will be open. Participants are encouraged to bring a 6" x 6" x 12" soft-sided cooler with NO glass and NO alcohol.
- xvii. Participants MUST stay in the Pit Area or Pit Grandstand, at ALL times. Participants are NOT permitted in the Grandstand Area throughout the event.
- xviii. All Purse & Award payouts will be via Direct Deposit or Check by mail. There will be NO payouts onsite.
 - xix. ALL Attendees must exit the facility no later than 1-hour following the Saturday Feature Checkered Flag.

Iowa mandates in place – May 25, 2020

CURRENT SCOTT COUNTY MANDATES IN PLACE – Issued May 21, 2020 (County)

i. Visitors are reminded to strictly abide to social distancing rules and not gather in groups of more than 10; stay home if feel sick, wash hands regularly, avoid touching

face, and bring supplies from home including disinfecting wipes, hand sanitizer, and other hygiene products.

CURRENT STATE PROCLAMATION - Issued 5/20/20 effective May 22, 2020 (State)

Proclamation Overview: Movie theatres, zoos, aquariums, museums, and wedding reception venues permitted to reopen with appropriate public health measures in place. Summer school activities including baseball and softball can resume June 1. Movie theatres must limit number of patrons to 50% of normal capacity while ensuring social distancing (six feet of physical distance) between each group or individual. Must follow guidance issued by Iowa Department of Public Health to reduce risk of transmission of COVID-19 including increased hygiene practices.

All other theatres and performance venues at which live performances are held shall continue to be closed.

ii. **Race Tracks:** A speedway or race track, other than a track conduction horse or dog races, may reopen its operations provided that it does not permit any spectators to attend its events in person.

Another State Proclamation is expected to be issued on Wednesday, May 27, 2020.

Exhibit C – Participant Guidelines

As we #ReturntoRacing you will read about [CLEAN-COVER-CONFINE]. As the country, and motorsports in particular, gradually eases back into business it is important to remember that everyone needs to remain aware of reducing and eventually eliminating the spread of COVID-19. Keeping these three simple words in mind as you go about your business will enable all of us to work toward the time when all tracks will reverberate to the sound of race cars and the cheering of race fans.

1. PRE-EVENT

a. HEALTH

- i. If Participant is sick or displays symptoms of COVID-19, STAY HOME
- ii. Covid-19 Symptoms includes Fever, Muscle Pain, Cough, Headache, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Sore Throat, Loss of Taste or Smell, Chills or Repeated Shaking with Chills.
- iii. CDC COVID-19 Symptoms/Symptoms of Coronavirus Guidelines: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptomstesting/symptoms.html

b. PERSONAL HYGIENE

- Participants should wash hands with soap and water every 20-minutes throughout the day...Sanitizer should ONLY support hand-washing, not take the place of. [CLEAN]
- ii. Participants should wash hands after being in a public place, after blowing nose, coughing, or sneezing; preparing and/or consuming food. **[CLEAN]**
- iii. Participants should avoid touching their face. [CLEAN-COVER]

c. **PREPARATION**

- Maximum sixty (60) car field for the World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Models, IMCA Late Models (Friday) and DIRTcar UMP Modifieds (Saturday) by pre-registration ONLY
- ii. This event is NOT open to the public. You must pre-register to participate in this event. All pre-registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
 Once the registration limit has been met, we will no longer accept registrations.
 Registration will close at 8:00pm EST on Thursday, May 28. No registrations will be accepted at the gate.
- iii. Entry & Pit Pass payment must be submitted by May 28, 2020 (*Thursday*) at 8:00pm EST.
- iv. Participants are encouraged to bring cloth Face Cover (or similar) and Gloves...PLEASE DO NOT use any medical-style Face Masks or Gloves that would otherwise be used by a health care worker. Special consideration may need to be given to the fact that some Staff will be communicating via 2-way or 1-way radios. [COVER]
- v. Event Organizer and/or Officiating Crew will provide Participants with Participant Notes & Event Guidelines will go out when registration opens.

d. **CLEANING**

- i. Participants and Race Teams should professionally clean & disinfect all equipment prior to arrival to the Facility. **[CLEAN]**
- ii. It is highly recommended that all trucks, trailers, motorhomes and personal vehicles be actively disinfected through a wipe-down process by individual attendees prior to arrival at the Event. Professional cleaning services may be considered by some Participants. [CLEAN]

e. **CONSIDERATIONS**

b. ARRIVAL

- Participants will not be allowed to enter the Facility before 3pm on Friday and Noon on Saturday and ALL TEAM MEMBERS (*6 - Driver & Crew Members*) should arrive together with their confirmation letter.
 Participants in personal vehicles should arrive at the same time as their Race Hauler. ALL Participants must enter facility between 3-5pm on Friday and Noon-4pm on Saturday.
- Upon arrival to the Facility you should be prepared for a COVID-19
 Screening up to and including a Temperature Test and completion of a health well-being questionnaire.
 - a. Temperature scanners will be used to test all Attendees entering the Facility. Any Attendee with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will not be allowed into the Facility.
- iii. Participants will be escorted to the pit area and should leave one (1) parking space (15') in between ALL Race Haulers. [CONFINE]

c. TRANSACTIONS

i. It is encouraged that ALL transactions are by Credit or Debit Card.

d. SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Participants should practice Social Distancing (6' separation per individual) at ALL times at the event including any necessary one-on-one conversation. [CONFINE]

g. ACCESSIBLE AREAS

h. SEATING

i. Participants should view all on-track action from the top of their respective Race Hauler. **[CONFINE]**

i. <u>CONCESSIONS</u>

- i. There will be food & beverage Concessions at this event.
- ii. Food and beverages should be consumed at respective Race Hauler.(there will be no "Food Court" or seating area for groups) [CONFINE]

j. **COMPETITION**

- i. World of Outlaws Morton Building Late Model Series
- ii. \$6,000-to-Win Friday night, \$10,000-to-Win Saturday night
- iii. 24-car Starting Field

3. POST-EVENT PLAN

a. EXIT

- i. ALL Participants MUST EXIT Facility by 10:30 pm.
- ii. Friday night ONLY: Race teams can stay overnight in their toterhomes.However, gathering should remain limited and all will have to submit to a COVID screening on Saturday.

b. PAYOUT

i. ALL purse and Contingency Award payouts will be distributed following the event via Direct Deposit and/or Check. There will be NO payout distribution onsite.

c. <u>CLEANING</u>

- i. Participants are strongly recommended to use active disinfection of high-use surfaces through a wipe-down prior to leaving the Facility. **[CLEAN]**
- ii. It is highly recommended that Participants conduct additional disinfection upon returning to their homes, places of business or race shops. It is encouraged to employ a lockdown strategy for a period of 96 hours. [CLEAN-CONFINE]
