



Spectator Guidelines "Snapshot"

- i. If you are sick or display symptoms of COVID-19, please STAY HOME
- ii. Ticket availability is limited. Fans are encouraged to purchase tickets in advance.Tickets may be available at the gate if seats are still available. All seating is General Admission. Pit Passes will be available at the gate
- iii. Onsite Ticket sales will open at 8am each day. Grandstand Gates and Suite Level will open at 5:30pm each day. The elevator will open for guests who are immunocompromised or 62 & Older starting at 4:30pm.
- iv. ALL Attendees can pay using cash or Credit/Debit card at Concessions and Merchandise trailers and MUST maintain social-distancing (6' separation) while in line.
- v. Fans can enter the facility at 5:30pm each day. There will be NO early entry. Fans are permitted to leave and re-enter the facility with proper credentials. The Pit Area will be open after the races and can ONLY be accessed through the Turn 4 crossover gate.
- vi. Upon arrival to the Facility you should be prepared for a COVID-19 Screening up to and including a Temperature Test. Anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19 or having a temperature over 100.3 degrees will be asked to leave the facility and see a physician.
- vii. Overnight camping is NOT available at Knoxville Raceway. The North Campground is available for \$40/night and must be booked in advance by calling 641.842.5431. This will be NOT be available at the gate.
- viii. You MUST exercise CDC Guidelines, including social-distancing (6' separation between groups) and NO groups larger than ten (10), while in the campground area. Failure to do so will require implementation of a curfew each evening.
 - ix. The seating is General Admission for this event and WILL follow the CDC and local Public Health Department guidelines for social-distancing up to and including 6' separation between all groups and seating every other row in ALL grandstands. ALL Fans MUST keep 6' separation from the group next to them on both sides at ALL times. Seating is ONLY available in even rows. Pit passes DO NOT grant you grandstand access.
 - x. It is recommended, but not required, all Spectators wear a cloth face cover at all times, but we strongly recommend this when outside of your group.
 - xi. ALL Attendees **MUST follow CDC Guidelines** throughout the entire event from entry onto the facility until exit up to and including Social-Distancing (6' separation).
