What is the Firecracker 100?

This is the 11th anniversary of the Firecracker 100. Each year this has continued to be a crown jewel event in Dirt Late Model Racing. Get ready for three nights of non-stop thrill racing and an incredible array of family-friendly events that allow fans of all ages to interact with their favorite drivers. Three nights, three complete shows, capped off by the 100-lap, \$30,000-to-win Firecracker 100 Feature.

When is it?

Thursday, Friday and Saturday, June 22-24, 2017.

Where is the track located?

Lernerville Speedway is located at 313 N. Pike Rd., Sarver, PA 16055.

Is Reserved Seating available?

Yes, the majority of the grandstands is designated as Reserved Seating. You can purchase advanced tickets online by clicking the "Buy Tickets" button on the schedule page at woolms.com/schedule or by calling 1-844-DIRT-TIX (347-8849). Tickets are also available for purchase at the Lernerville Speedway office. Advanced Reserved Packages include a free Fan Pit Pass for Thursday and Friday nights.



How do I buy a ticket?

All you have to do is click the "<u>Buy Tickets</u>" button on the schedule page at <u>woolms.com/schedule</u> or call 1-844-DIRT-TIX (347-8849). Tickets are also available for purchase at the Lernerville Speedway office.

How much are advanced tickets?

We offer various packages:

- Three-Day Packages:
 - Three-day Reserved Ticket Package is \$69.00 for adults, \$45.00 for students & children (17 and under).**
 - Three-day General Admission Ticket Package is \$69.00 for adults, \$45.00 for students (11-17), and children (10 and under) are FREE.
 - Three-day Pit Pass is \$90.00 for members, \$95.00 for non-members.
- Thursday- or Friday-only Ticket:
 - \$34.00 for Reserved/General Admission adult
 - \$30.00 for Reserved/General Admission student (11-17)
 - o FREE for Children (10 and under) in G.A. ONLY; \$30.00 for Reserved.
 - o Thursday or Friday Pit Pass: \$35.00 non-members, \$30.00 for members.
- Saturday-only Tickets:
 - \$40.00 for Reserved /General Admission adults
 - o \$25.00 for Reserved/General Admission students (11-17)
 - o FREE for children (10 and under) in G.A. ONLY; \$25.00 for Reserved.
 - Saturday Pit Pass: \$40.00

**DON'T FORGET: You also get a Free Fan Pit Pass for Thursday and Friday night with every <u>Reserved Package</u> you buy in <u>Advance</u>, so don't miss out on this great opportunity.

Will I still be able to purchase tickets the day of the event?

Yes, you will be able to purchase tickets the day of the race at the Main Ticket Booth at Lernerville Speedway. Tickets are selling fast, so get yours soon before it's too late.

Can I purchase a Pit Pass in advance?

Eligibility for the valuable insurance benefits and money-saving discounts offered to DIRTcar Members are verified in person, therefore Pit Passes are sold the day of show only. Pit Passes must be purchased in person at the Pit Window. Once there, you will be required to sign a Waiver and Release of Liability and will be issued a wristband.

What is the age limit for the pit area?

There is not an age limit for the pit area at this event. Minors 17 and younger must submit a fully-executed minor "Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement/Minor's Assumption of Risk and Release and Waiver of Liability." These will be available at the Pit Ticket Windows.

Can I upgrade my ticket to get a Pit Pass?

Yes, a Pit Pass upgrade will be \$10.00 for adults.

Is camping available?

Of course! With so much excitement going on you're never going to want to leave the track grounds. Camping will be \$50 for the entire weekend. We offer a variety of camping packages to suit all types of parties. There will be family-friendly and party-friendly reserved areas as well as the always popular trackside camping. Call 724-353-1511 for details on reserving your spot today. Firewood and ice will also be readily available at the track for purchase.

Who is performing in concert?

What is there to do between the races?

Fans can participate in the 5th annual kicking it to cancer Kickball Game, sponsored by the Jeff Gordon Foundation to raise money and awareness for children with cancer. Following the game we will have our Action/Raffle that fans will have the chance to bid on their favorite driver's memorabilia. There will also be Cornhole & Horseshoe Tournaments, a driver Autograph Session, weenie roast, and finishing the night off with a post-race concert in the parking lot on Thursday & Friday nights.

How do I sign up for Cornhole and Horseshoe Tournament?

Contestants will be chosen throughout the three-day Firecracker weekend in a variety of ways: T-shirt tosses, trivia questions, and sign-ups at the Lernerville and World of Outlaw Craftsman Late Model Series souvenir trailer.

Are coolers permitted?

Small "personal size" coolers are permitted at Lernerville Speedway as long as they contain no glass containers and no alcoholic beverages. Alcohol must be left at the campsite or purchased inside the race track.

Will Pits be open after the race?

Yes, the Pits will be open after the completion of all on-track activities on Saturday night. Fans can see their favorite drivers and cars up close and in person!

Where can I find the Official Entry Application?

Officials Entry Applications are available for download on the Firecracker 100 page of the Lernerville.com webpage or by calling the Lernerville Speedway office at 704-353-1511. Drivers can also pick up entry forms at the Pit Board any Friday night.

What are the tire rules?

Late Models 20,30,40.

What is the purse?

The purse is \$6,000-to-win both Thursday and Friday nights. Saturdays "Uncle Sam" Feature will be a \$3,000-to-win, and finishing off the night will be a \$30,000-to-win main Feature.

What is the process of requesting media credentials?
